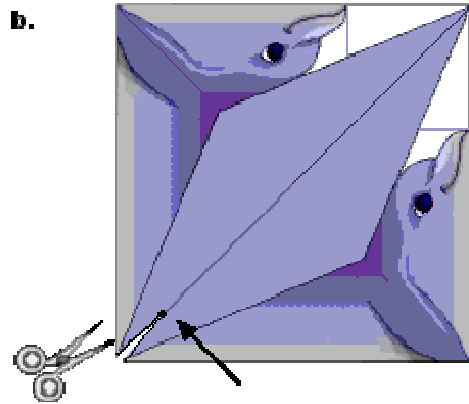
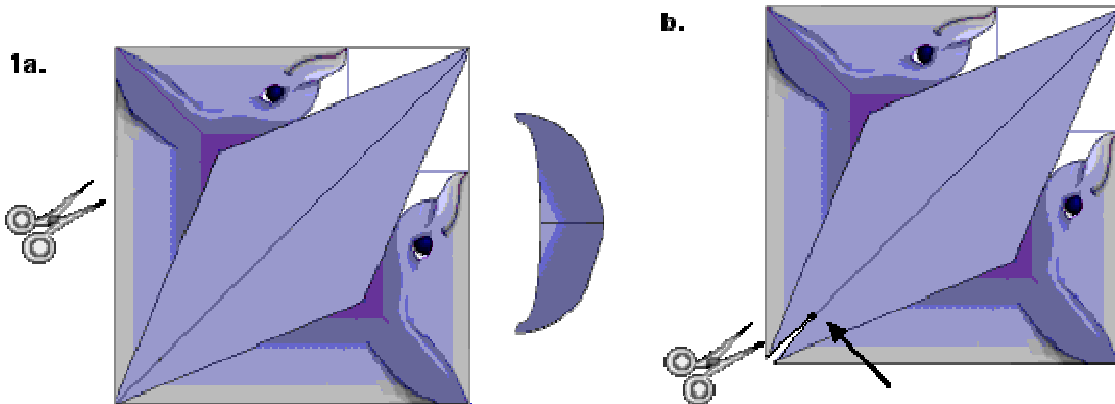
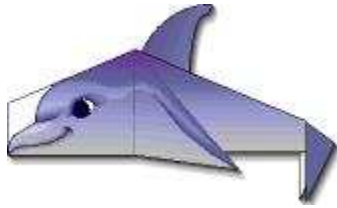
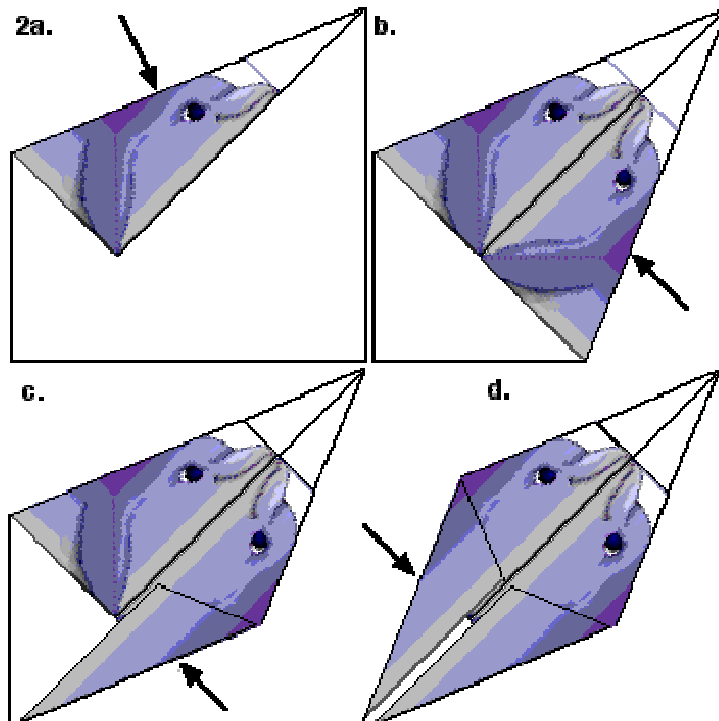


Dolphin Origami Directions

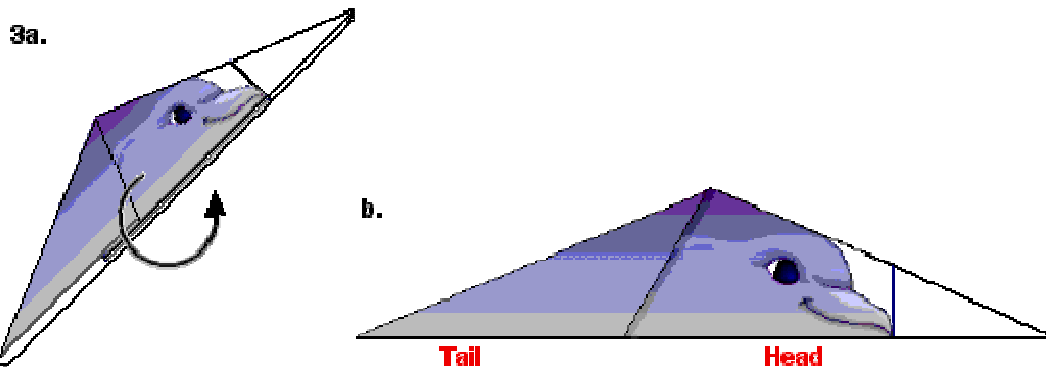


- A. Cut out origami and dorsal fin along outer solid lines.
B. Snip end of tale, as illustrated, to black dot.

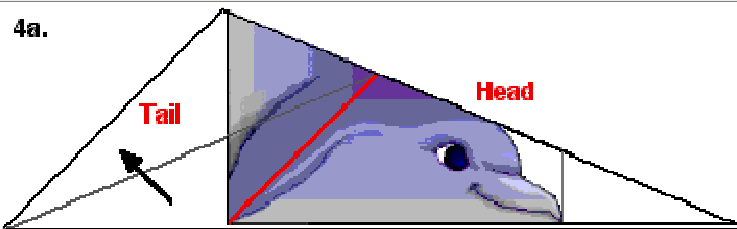


- A. Turn paper over. With printed side facing down, fold along line A as illustrated.

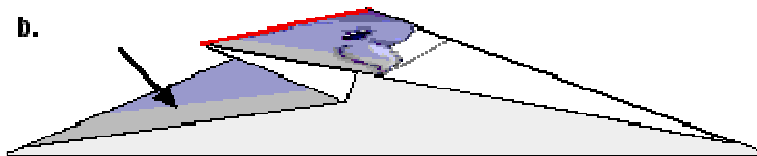
- B. Repeat fold along line B.
- C. Fold along line C.
- D. Fold along line D.



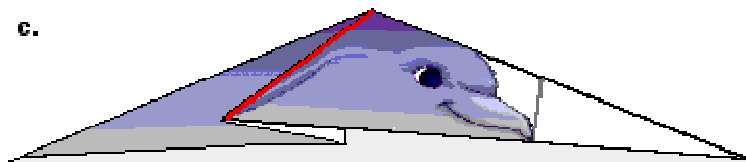
- A. Fold in half, along diagonal line, as illustrated.
- B. Your origami should look like this, with a "tail" flap and a "head" flap.



- A. Unfold "tail" flap. Take note of the diagonal line, highlighted here in red, on the dolphin/whale's flipper.

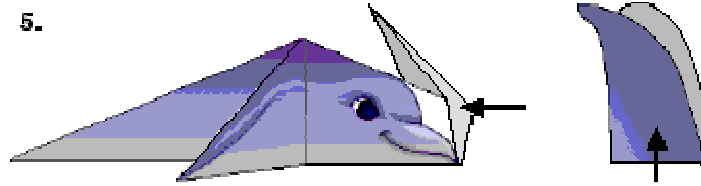


- B. Folding "tail" flap **first**, crease dolphin's flipper along the highlighted line as you fold "head" flap over.



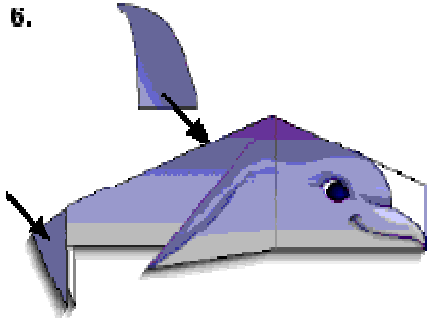
- C. Your origami should now look like this, with the flipper folded as shown.

- A. "Valley" fold origami tip **inward** along line E as illustrated.
B. Fold dorsal fin in half, along solid line, as illustrated.
